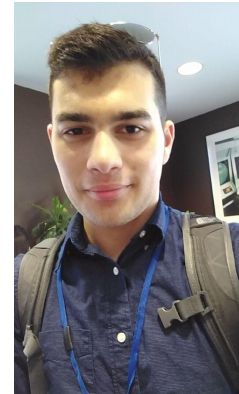
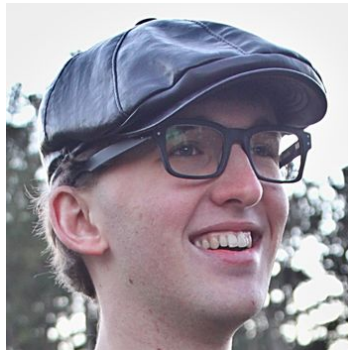
Meeting format
